

TOWN OF IRA

Trash and Recycling with D& L Trash Pick Up Service
Wolcott, NY (594-9251)
Saturdays from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM
At the Ira Town Barn, Corner of Bradt Road and Ira Station Road

RESIDENTS OF THE TOWN OF IRA ONLY must purchase a valid permit from the Town of Ira Clerk to bring no more than one pickup load of trash to the transfer station at the rear of the Town of Ira Barn per week. The numbered permit must be displayed on the driver's side window and visible to the attendant.

1. **The load must be covered to comply with NYSDEC Law.**
You May be turned away at the transfer station if load is uncovered. Repeat offenses will result in a revoked permit.
2. Daily household waste in a clear plastic bag will be accepted weekly.
3. Hazardous household waste and paint will not be accepted. However dry paint containers with the top removed will be accepted.
4. Construction and demolition debris shall be limited to small quantities – not pickup loads or part of a house or building. Lumber shall not exceed 5-foot lengths.
5. Yard waste will not be accepted since it is compostable. **THE LANDFILL WILL NOT ACCEPT YARD WASTE.**
6. Large items such as appliances and furniture will be accepted between 8:00 AM and 2:00 PM only. There is a limit of one large item per week per residence.
7. A refrigerator must be free of Freon to be accepted. Otherwise you may take a refrigerator to the Auburn Landfill on North Division Street where they will remove the Freon and dispose of the refrigerator for a fee of \$25.00.
8. There is a charge of \$4.00 per car tire-limit of two tires a week. Larger tires not accepted.
9. You must purchase a dump permit to bring recyclables to the transfer station.

YOUR TAXES PAY FOR THIS SERVICE PLEASE DESTROY PERMIT IF YOU MOVE FROM THE TOWN.

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Containers

CLEAN AND DRAIN, Glass: clear, brown & green – Throw away all tops

CLEAN AND DRAIN, Metal Cans: all metal cans and aluminum foil – Cut top and bottom out of cans and Flatten

Plastic containers #1 thru #7:

CLEAN AND DRAIN, Flatten milk jugs (**plastic only**, paper cartons are not recyclables) - Throw away all tops

Flat Papers

Newspapers and Pennysavers – All daily & weekly newspapers, including glossy inserts flatten and fold neatly.

Corrugated Cardboard –Boxes three layers – wavy middle layer. Flatten boxes. Cut to no longer than 2 ft. x 4 ft. Remove staples, tape and labels.

Boxboard – Cereal, cracker and gift boxes – Flatten. Place with newspapers.

Other Papers – All papers that are not newspapers: magazines, advertising mail, Catalogs, envelopes, school papers – Separate from newspapers, boxboard and cardboard.

Please flatten all metal cans, all plastic containers. If you flatten these items, we will be able to get more recyclables in the bins. This will help the capacity problem. Spray paint cans are not recyclable. Paper milk cartons and juice boxes are not recyclable as they have a wax coating.

TRANSFER STATION – TOWN OF IRA
CORNER OF BRADT ROAD AND IRA STATION ROAD
DUMP HOURS 8:00 AM – 3: 00 PM ON
EVERY SATURDAY THROUGH THE YEAR

When approaching the transfer station you must enter transfer station off from Bradt Road ONLY.

Drive thru to the end of the Highway garage and have your permit checked. Once you have been cleared to dump proceed to the trucks that are going to Receive your trash (10 PMH, use caution, 2 lanes only) or as directed by on site personnel.

Exit onto Ira Station Road only. The Town of Ira asks you help (please) in abiding to the rules as spelled out for the transfer station.

Do not use your vehicles and permit to bring someone else's trash to the Town of Ira. Everyone in the Town of Ira needs to cooperate and follow the rules for the transfer station.

**P.S. Remember to have your Permit with you at all times.
You must use the vehicle that shows on your permit.**
