DISCUSSION:

Lon Fricano – TLC Ambulance Services: discussion about a medical dispatcher being placed at 911 center at no cost to County. Explains there is no cost for them to bring in the personal or the service and there is nothing in it for TLC. The expense goes to the services provided to the person who uses it. Cortland County has same arrangement. Fricano stressed to 911 employees that this is not a take away it's and add on and we need to be the best we can be.

Caption Gallivan of NYSP explains reorganization of the troopers due to shortage. Captain Gallivan explained that Cayuga County actually gained 1 more trooper and not losing anyone due to the budget crisis in Albany.

Stayton provides department updates. In 2011 dispatcher will be sent to training sessions for two weeks. Stayton request permission to carry over 70 hours of vacation time into 2011. Committee approves.

Dahl requests 70 hours of vacation time carry-over into 2011. Committee approves.

Dahl has another resolution for EMO SHSP GRANT. Cuddeback directs him to bring it to Ways & Means Committee.

Sheriff announces that Cayuga County has received their accreditation from Albany.
